Half term Intervention (19th – 23rd October 2020)

Please find below a table showing the intervention days running over the half term period (19th-23rd October inclusive). All sessions are **invitation-only**, where students have been invited to attend a session, it is **strongly advised** that they attend.

Staff have reviewed curriculum plans and prioritised the activities to be completed over the October break to both support your child in any catch-up and prepare them for next summer's GCSEs. This may vary from subject to subject dependent on the needs of the course. Some subjects have chosen not to run sessions at this point, but do plan to run further catch-up support later in the year. For all courses, only essential students for the activities have been invited.


