Results

On candidate statements of results (results slips) and certificates, grades will be reported in the same way as in previous years.

Results will be issued on results days in August as follows:

Date	Qualification type
10/08/2021 (8:30 – 11:30am)	GCE (AS, A Levels) and other Level 3 qualifications
12/08/2021 (8:30 – 11:30am)	GCSE and other Level 1/2 qualifications

Arrangements for results days

Results will be available to collect from school between 8:30am and 11:30am on the relevant results days. Students will come in to school through reception and be able to collect their results in the dining room. Year 13's will then be able to discuss next steps with members of staff if required and Year 11's will be able to enrol into 6th form before leaving via the dance studio. No results can be given out before 8:30am therefore please don't arrive too early. Any results unable to be collected on the day will be posted home first class.

Concerns about your results

When you receive your results, if you think that a grade is wrong, your first step should be to speak to staff on the day or to email appeals@snacademy.org.uk for advice. Further details of the arrangements for appeals are provided on the school website (<http://www.southnottinghamshireacademy.org.uk/year-11-and-13-cags>). An appeal will only be able to be processed when we receive a completed, dated and signed Student Request for Centre Reviews and Appeals Form (Stage one – Section A).

Certificates

When certificates have been received from the awarding organisations, usually around mid November, we will send students a letter letting them know that they are available for collection and they will be able to sign for them at reception. It is important that you keep us updated with any change of address within this time. If students are still at school we will get them to sign for them during a tutor time. Certificates only need to be held by us for a year before they can be destroyed. It is important for students to collect their certificates as these are the only proof of their grades and getting replacements from the exam boards will involve a cost.
